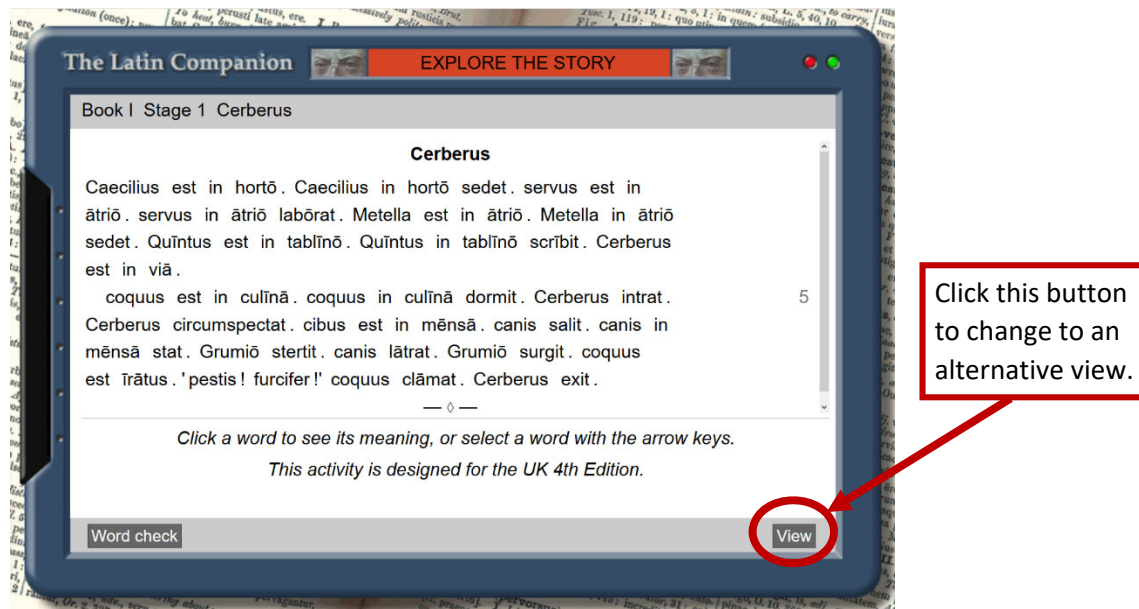


Cambridge School Classics Project: Did you know?

Each 'Story Explorer' of the UK 4th edition has several options for changing the way the text is displayed.



Clicking 'view' brings up a version of the same explorer, with the same text and functionality, but without the 'Latin Companion' frame. Six options appear at the bottom of the page.



'view' takes you back to the default 'Latin Companion' view.

'background' cycles through a range of alternative background colours.

'text' cycles through a range of text colours.

'space' makes the spaces between the words larger.

'breaks' toggles the line breaks so the text flows all the way across the page, with line numbers at the relevant points in the text.

Clicking 'breaks' also brings up the options 'a-' and 'a+', which can be used to decrease and increase the size of the text.
